Road gritters safely stored with FlexRoad

When Ramco UK Ltd, a surplus equipment auction house, won an asset reuse contract for National Highways, it was tasked with selling various fleet vehicles, including winter road gritters and ploughs.

On commencement of the contract, over 100 gritters needed to be collected from various National Highways sites across the United Kingdom, and transported to Ramco's facility to be prepared for resale - all within 8 weeks!

To accommodate the surge, Ramco required additional yard space, which meant temporarily converting agricultural grazing land into a vehicle storage area capable of supporting the weight.

With a herd of cows moved on to greener pastures, FlexRoad's team promptly deployed 34 rolls of matting (covering over 4000m2!), enabling Ramco to fulfill the needs of the contract without disruption. Better yet, the mats provided protection for the ground below, meaning it could be restored to agricultural land with ease.



The matting was deployed at short notice and withstood the extremely wet winter months. After it was uplifted, the field was returned to grazing for cattle with very little impact on the environment and ground below.
